




Supplies Checklist




On The Day

When you arrive on the 28th of March, the Kougom team will be there to welcome you and your parents for the opening service (at Kopanong Church). If you are not registered yet, don't worry, we will quickly walk you through it and help you as well as assist you with the payment. After the service, you can greet your parents and we will depart with busses to the campsite.



COVID Regulations



Because we are still in the pandemic, we need to be safe and contribute to stopping the transmission of the virus.

Therefore, we request that you please submit a **Vaccination Certificate** (attainable at: <https://vaccine.certificate.health.gov.za/>)

OR

a **Negative COVID Test** (PCR or Antigen tests only, Antibody test not accepted) on arrival on the 28th of March.

Should you have contracted the virus and completed your isolation period prior to the camp, you can present the test results as supplied by the laboratory instead of the two options listed above. Tests with a positive result between 28 December 2021 - 18 March 2022 will be accepted.
